Networking/1: This competency-based course is the first in a sequence of two courses designed to prepare students to pass the Cisco Certified Entry Networking Technician (CCENT) examination. *180 Hours*

Networking/2: This competency-based course is the second in a sequence of two courses designed to prepare students to pass the Interconnecting Cisco Certified Entry Networking Technician (CCENT) examination. *180 Hours*

Network Control Operator

This competency-based course is designed to provide students with an introduction to network administration. It includes general networking concepts, and reinforcement of the relationship between desktop networking components. This course also includes instruction in employability skills. *180 Hours*

The competencies in these courses are aligned with the California High School Academic Content Standards and the California Career Technical Education Model Curriculum Standards.
