

Dental Assistant



In this sequence of three courses, students gain the skills required to assist Dentists with their patients. You will learn the fundamentals of:

- **Dental Health Education**
- **Dental Specialties**
- **Oral Anatomy**
- **Chair-side Assisting**
- **Dental Materials**
- **Radiology**
- **Medical Emergencies**

Course includes internship in a Dentist's office. *180 Hours each course.* Completion of the course *Medical Terminology* is strongly recommended prior to enrolling in the *Dental Assistant* course.
